Killing of Taj DU probe body submits report to VC

The enquiry committee to probe into the killing of student at Bangabandhu Hall and firing on a procession from Surya Sen Hall of Dhaka University submitted its report to the university authority on Wednesday, reports UNB.

The committee was formed after a Bangla Department student, Arif Hossain Taj, was shot dead and some others were injured at Bangabandhu Hall on March 13 and miscreants opened fire on a procession from Surya Sen Hall on March 15.

Chairman of the committee Barrister Mainul Hosein handed over the report to Vice Chancellor Prof AK Azad Chowdhury in the morning. Pro-VC Prof. Shahid Uddin Ahmed and members of the committee were present.

Member secretary of the committee, DU proctor Dr AKM Nur-un-Nabi, handed over a summary of the report to the vice chancellor.

Other members of the committee were President of DU Teachers Association Prof M Mostafa Chowdhury, Dean of the Arts Faculty Prof Aminul Islam and DU Syndicate members Prof Mustafizur Rahman, Prof Khandker Bazlul Haq and Prof ATM Zahurul Haq.

Accepting the report, VC Azad Chowdhury thanked the members of the committee and said its recommendations would be implemented.

after the report was approved by the DU Syndicate, said a Press release.

The recommendations are related to administrative condition of residential halls, law and order situation, role of law enforcing agencies, campus security, effectiveness of present DUCSU and hall unions.

The committee members, during their investigation, visited Bangabandhu Hall and Surya Sen Hall and interviewed the injured students at Pangu Hospital and Suhrawardy Hospital.

They held 14 meetings and talked to provosts of different dormitories, house tutors, students, security guards, employees, police personnel, leaders of student organisations and university correspondents of different dailies and news agencies.
