

Constitution amended

DUCSU executives can hold office for 365 days

The Dhaka University Syndicate in a meeting on Wednesday amended two articles of the Constitution of the Dhaka University Central Students' Union (DUCSU).

The amended articles are 6 (c) and 18 of the DUCSU Constitution.

According to the amended Articles, the elected office-bearers of the DUCSU shall hold office for 365 days. In case the election could not be held in time the elected office-bearers shall continue for a further 90 days or till holding the election within those 90 days.

The Articles 6 (C) was first passed in 1974 by the Syndicate and before the amendment the DUCSU office-bearers could continue in the posi-

tion until the next election was held. According to the Constitution, VC is the President of DUCSU and as a President he/she could dissolve the DUCSU.

Following the amendment to Article 18, the elected office-bearers of Hall Unions shall hold office for 365 days. In case the election could not be held in time, the elected office-bearers shall continue for further 90 days or till holding the election within those 90 days.

VC Prof AK Azad Chowdhury chaired the Syndicate meeting.

Sources said, the university authorities dissolved the existing bodies of DUCSU and Hall Unions about nine months ago. The last election of DUCSU was held in 1990.
