Sex-scandal

DU students stage sit-in

The movement of a section of general students of Dhaka University on Thursday were seen to be divided over the sex-scandal of a teacher.

A fraction of the general students said that they had left the original platform as some of their demands according to the fraction, were not appropriate.

Both the fractions on Thursday staged sit-in demonstrations in front of the registrar building to press home their own demands.

Earlier the newly emerged group comprising all male student held a rally at the Aparajeya Bangla and accused the other platform of tainting the image of the university.

However the original sector of general students denied any connection with the newly emerged group.

Later in the evening they held a Press conference at the Madhu's canteen. They warned of a tougher movement on the campus if its demands were not fulfilled immediately.

At a separate Press conference the leaders of Ganatantrik Chhatra Oikya condemned the general students for mentioning the names of the alleged teachers in their slogan before the allegation is proved.

Earlier on Tuesday at the Paribesh Parishad meeting, leaders of all the student organisations appreciated the initiatives taken by the university authorities regarding the sex-scandal of a teacher of International Relations Department.
