

DU to rehabilitate students of 4 halls today

All genuine students of Suryasen Hall, Poet Jasimuddin Hall, Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman Hall and Muktijoddah Ziaur Rahman Hall of Dhaka University who were staying outside due to recent campus turmoil would be rehabilitated at their respective halls today (Thursday).

The university authorities have taken adequate measures for peaceful rehabilitation of all genuine resident students today. These four halls of the university will be vacated at 9 a.m. today (Thursday) and then genuine students will be allowed to enter into their respective halls after checking their identity cards by the authorities concerned.

Meanwhile, an emergency meeting of Dhaka University Syndicate was held on Wednesday afternoon with the Vice-Chancellor Prof AK Azad Chowdhury in the chair.

The Vice-Chancellor apprised the Syndicate members of the latest situation and the steps taken for rehabilitation of the genuine students at their respective dormitories today. He also informed the meeting that a total of 97 students were found genuine out of 238 students of the list given earlier by Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD). After checking the JCD's list it was found that only 24 students out of 104 were found genuine at Bangabandhu Hall, 23 students are genuine out of 58 at Jasimuddin Hall, 21 students are genuine out of 42 at

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Zia Hall and 29 students are genuine out of 34 at Suryasen Hall.

The Syndicate took some decisions in the meeting to maintain a peaceful atmosphere on the campus. As per the decision all kinds of meetings, processions, rallies and slogans would be banned today (Thursday) on the campus to help rehabilitate genuine students smoothly.

The meeting urged the Vice-Chancellor to hold talks with all student organisations so that such ban on meetings and processions might be continued for a few days to avert any further clash on the campus.

It also called upon all political parties and student bodies to extend their help and cooperation to restore and maintain a congenial academic atmosphere on the Dhaka University campus.
