DU urges all to refrain from any campaign

Dhaka University registrar Mohammad Selim in a statement on Friday said that the Vice-Chancellor of the University formed an enquiry committee with some syndicate members to investigate into the allegations brought against some teachers of the university.

This committee has already started its investigation and, therefore, all quarters have been urged not to make any campaign either in favour or against any circle.

Meanwhile, Dhaka University Teachers Association (DUTA) president Prof AFM Yousuf Haider and general secretary Prof M Hossain Mansur in a joint statement on Fri-

day expressed their deep concern at the recent reports published in different national dailies against some teachers of the university centering immoral activities.

They said that legal actions must be taken against those teachers who would be found responsible by the enquiry committee. They alleged that some quarters were out to tarnish the image of the university teachers by publishing reports against the teachers community in general. They strongly protested and condemned such activities and called upon all to refrain from doing so.
