

GCO calls strike in DU tomorrow

Ganatantrik Chhatra Oikya (GCO), an alliance of five left-leaning student organisations will observe strike in Dhaka University tomorrow (Thursday) demanding withdrawal of enhanced tuition and other student fees.

GCO leaders announced the strike programme from a rally held on the university campus last week.

Meanwhile, different student organisations termed the clarification of the University authorities regarding the enhancement of tuition fee and other fees that published in different national dailies recently as "cleverly statement".

Bangladesh Chhatra Union (BCU) leaders at a Press conference on Tuesday said that the university authority's statement would mislead the students and their guardians. They expressed deep concern over the statement issued by the university authorities.

They urged the students to make tomorrow's (Thursday) strike a success and threaten to launch tougher movement if their demand was not realised by tomorrow (Thursday).

The press conference held at Modhu's Canteen of Dhaka University was attended by Hasan Hafizur Rahman, Monzoori Khoda Torik and Sharifuzzaman Sharif.

President of Bangladesh Chhatra Federation (BCF) Junaied Saki and General Secretary Uzzal Balo in a statement on Tuesday termed the university authority's statement as "conspiratory".
