Speedy probe into DU sex scandal urged

A group of the general students of Dhaka University, Bangladesh Chhatra Front and Chhatra Union on Tuesday separately submitted memorandum to the Vice-Chancellor of the university demanding speedy investigation into the alleged sexual abuse against a teacher.

The issue has created a great resentment among students. General students on Tuesday held a rally at the Aparajeyo Bangla condemning the alleged sexual abuse.

Earlier on November 29 a female student of the university complained to the Vice-Chancellor of being sexually assaulted by a senior teacher of the International Relations Department. The authorities on the next day formed a four-member probe body to investigate into the matter.

The probe body was requested to submit its report within 15 days. The deadline expired on Tuesday without any report.

Shamajtantrik Chhatra Front leaders at a rally in front of the office of the Vice-Chancellor demanded the probe body to be headed by a female teacher to have a detailed report from victim.

The general students in their memorandum also requested the authorities to have a female representative from the student in the probe body. They announced a demonstration programme on December 20.
