

448 DU teachers submit memo to President to uphold constitution

Four hundred forty eight teachers of Dhaka University in a memorandum on Friday called upon President Prof Dr Iajuddin Ahmed to appoint the immediate past Chief Justice as the Chief Advisor of the caretaker government, reports BSS.

They called upon the President to show his responsibility, sincerity as well as courage by upholding the constitution. It will also help holding a free and fair election and keep the democratic process continue.

In this connection, the people of the country will be with the President, they added.

The Dhaka University teachers said "We are noticing it with deep concern that some quarters have been trying to misguide the nation by giving various explanation of

the constitution regarding the caretaker government."

"We request you to bestow the responsibility of the Chief Advisor of the caretaker government to such a person who according to the constitution is eligible for the post considering greater interest of the nation. It is the expectation of people to you," they added.
