

Newashi School facing teacher shortage

KURIGRAM, July 18.—Newashi High School in Nageswari Upazila of Kurigram district has been facing multifarious problems due to shortage of funds, teaching staff, accommodation and lack of other educational facilities.

Established in 1972, the only secondary school in the area can not admit required number of students for want of accommodation. As a result, many students are deprived of education every year.

The roll strength of the school is about 350 but the school has no necessary number of benches. Besides, chair, table and almirah are insufficient.

Due to shortage of books in the library, the students can hardly prepare their studies. Science laboratory accommodated in a small room has been running without requisite equipment resulting in untold sufferings the science students the school has no sports appliances.

Shortage of teachers is hampering the education of the students.
