## APSU fails to hold rally in CU

CHITTAGONG, Aug. 19.— The All Party Students Unity (APSU) could not hold its scheduled rally and demonstrations in Chittagong University today. The APSU supporters could not even come in the university campus which is now under seize of Shibir activists. However, some of the APSU supporters manage to come upto campus railway station to attend the scheduled rally and demonstrations.

But they were unable to make their way into the university breaking the cordon of Shibir activists. The APSU scheduled programme in defiance of Shibirs fresh round of 72-hour strike panicked everybody to

day in Chittagong University. While the APSU gave the programme to press demand for freeing the campus from the clutches of what it called terrorists. The Islami Chhatra Shibir called 72-hour strike in support of its demands for arrest of those persons who launched an armed attack on resident students last Wednesday.

The normal life in Chittagong University came to total halt on the first day of 72-hour strike call given by the Islami Chhatra Shibir. Except the Shibir supporters, the other students could not turn up on the campus. The Faculties and Administrative Office remained almost deserted. The teachers apparently preferred stay back home.

The Shibir backed Sangrami Chhatra Oikya held a rally and took out procession today on the campus. The rally was addressed by its leaders Hamidur Rahman Azad, Mostafa Kamal Chowdhury and Rezaul Karim. The Islami Chhatra Shibir also held a big rally at Laldighi Maidan on Monday afternoon. The rally was presided over by Shibir's city unit President Mostafa Kamal Chowdhury.

The APSU also held a rally at Anderkilla on Sunday afternoon. The rally presided over by CUGSU Vice-President Mohammed Nazimuddin was addressed among others by Karim Dulal and Mahbubur Rahman. The speakers reiterated their demands for purge of hoodlums and recovery of illegal arms from the university. After rally, a banner was also brought out.
