

Provost body condemns ransacking of V-C's office

An emergency meeting of the Provost Committee of Dhaka University on Wednesday night expressed deep anxiety at undesirable incident at the Jagannath Hall and condemned all such terrorist activities on the campus, reports BSS.

A Press release issued by the Provost Committee said the meeting also condemned the ransacking of the residence of the Provost of Jagannath Hall and threatening to the members of his family.

The meeting expressed sympathy to the provost, the residential teachers and the students of the Hall who were injured in Tuesday night's incident.

The Press release said the meeting also condemned the threat on life of

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the Provost of Salimullah Hall and his family members and ransacking of the house of Mr. Balayet Hossain, a House Tutor of the Hall.

The meeting demanded full inquiry into the incidents in these two Halls and exemplary punishment to the offenders.

The meeting decided to hold a joint meeting of all House Tutors, Asstt. Teachers, Proctors and Asstt. Proctors of all halls.

The meeting condemned the terrorist activities including ransacking the house and office of the Vice-Chancellor and the Registrar and damaging the car of a University teacher.

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
