35 students held from Balaka Hall

Police on Saturday arrested 35 unruly students from Balaka Cinema Hall premises for alleged forcible occupation of seats in the hall, ransacking of shops and arson, police sources said, reports BSS.

It was reported that a group of students mostly from Dhaka city college forced out the film viewers at Balaka Cinema Hall at 12 noon and occupied their seats illegally disrespecting the request of the hall authority.

The unruly students also ransacked some shops in the area and put on fire a footpath shop, the sources added.

During the incident police arrested 35 students mostly from Dhaka City College and sent them to court.

According to a police Press release, Tejgaon Thana Police arrested an alleged mastan and toll collector Jasim from PWD Bhaban, Sher-e-Bangla Nagar last night.

Jasim entered into the PWD Sher-e-Bangla Nagar office with illegal arms on September 15 and demanded toll and contractory works from Engineer Rajuddin, a case was registered with Tejgaon Thana in this connection, the Press release added.

Gulshan Thana Police arrested accused Shahjahan (20) alongwith a country made pipe gun and two rounds of cartridges from Badda this morning.

62 from Shymoli

Police picked up 62 students from Shyamoli cinema hall at noon on (Saturday) for their alleged forcible entry into the hall to witness a Bangla cinema, reports UNB.

Police sources said about 100 students of Bangla College of Mirpur entered the hall forcibly without tickets to watch the newly released Bangla cinema "Sonia".

On a complaint from the hall manager, police rushed to the spot and picked up 62 students from the hall but some others managed to escape.

However, a regular cinegoer alleged that the hall management always sold most of the tickets to black marketeers at higher price. They even do not open the sales counter before the show.

The students might have entered the hall forcibly failing to procure tickets from the counters, he said.
