

BCL holds rally at DU

Bangladesh Chhatra League (S-P) brought out a procession and held a rally on the Dhaka University campus on Thursday in protest against the terrorists activities of Shibir in Chittagong University.

Addressing the rally the BCL leaders said the terrorists of Islami Chhatra Shibir were creating reign of terror in Chittagong University and some other educational institutions in the country.

They termed the Chhatra Shibir as anti-liberation force and urged the student community to face them unitedly.

They criticised the former BNP government and said the BNP in collaboration with Jamaat-e-Islami went to power.

The rally held in front of the DUCSU building was addressed among others, by BCL President

supporters have been staying inside the campus.

In the morning, the Proctor Professor Ahmed Hossain along with Assistant Proctor Dr Tawhid Hossain, came upto the university entrance (Madanhat) to receive a memorandum of the Chhatra League. Their demands were to flush out Shibir's armed cadre members from the campus and dormitories and arrest of those Shibir activists who were responsible for inflicting injuries to Chhatra League leader Abul Kashem.

In the evening, the Islami Chhatra Shibir at a Press conference in the city put up six-point demand which include expulsion of trouble makers belonging to the Chhatra League, arrest of those persons who responsible for the assault of Syndicate member Professor Emdadul Huq and creation of congenial academic atmosphere in the university. The Shibir leaders threatened to launch a greater movement unless their demands are not met by September 26.

The Vice-Chancellor Professor Rafiqul Islam Chowdhury held a meeting with the senior teachers, Dean of all faculties, Provosts and Proctor at his residence this evening to discuss the latest situation prevailing on the campus. The Pro-Vice Chancellor Professor Abu Yusuf Alam was also present at the meeting.

Exams postponed

Meanwhile, BSS adds: The authority of the Chittagong University has decided to postpone all examinations of different academic years till October 1 due to unavoidable reasons.

According to university sources, the next date of the postponed examinations will be announced later.
