Students urged to uphold unity

The all-party students alliance urged the students to uphold students unity at all costs, reports BSS.

The students hoisted black flags at zero point of G.P.O in the city. All party students alliances held a brief rally in front of the National Press Club on Friday.

President of Bangladesh Chhatra Union, Mustafizur Rahman Babul addressed the rally.

He said, we are now united, no repression could suppress the current democratic movement. Stressing the need for unity of the peoples of all walks of life, he said that the united movement of the people would enable them to win their rights. He was also critical of brutalities on students and people during the recent movement and demanded judicial inquiry into the incidents of police firing in which at least seven persons were killed.
