Sreepur College facing crisis

MAGURA Oct. 19.—Sreepur College of Sreepur Upazila has been facing multifarious problems including shortage of teachers, accommodation, furniture and inadequate equipments in science Laboratory and lack of necessary appliances for games and sports.

Sreepur College, the only institution for higher education of this upazila does not have sufficient accommodation. There are only few rooms in the college building which are being used for holding classes and office.

Seat arrangement cannot meet the need for want of necessary under of benches. Besides,

furniture including chair, table and almirah are also insufficient. Due to inadequate number of books in the library, the students can hardly meet their requirements of studies.

Shortage of teachers is hampering the very purpose of education of the college. Only a few teachers in the college can not meet the demand of the students.

People of the area have urged the authority concerned to do the needful for providing necessary assistance for smooth running of the college.

Hazardous bus journey

Bus journey from Magura to Sreepur Road has become hazardous due to the worst condition of the road and as a result of this frequent road mishap occurs.

Everyday a number of buses run by this road. But due to narrow ness of the road, even two mini buses coming from opposite directions cannot negotiate each other. The road has innumerable cracks.
