APSU calls 12-hr hartal Nov 26

The all-Party Students Unity (APSU) and the Central Jubo Sangram Parishad have given a call for country-wide dawn to dusk hartal on November 26 in protest against the armed attack on the students by the private force of a party and its front organisations on November 17. Islami Chhatra Shibir also announced its programme for 24-hour hartal on November 26.

It may be mentioned here that Jatiya Party earlier announced that it will hold grand rally in Dhaka city on November 26 where President Ershad will be the main speaker.

The Eight-Party, Seven-Party and Five-party Alliances have already extended their support to the dawn to dusk country-wide hartal on November 26 by APSU and Jubo Sangram Parishad. Jamaat-e-Islami also supported the hartal programme of the students.

The APSU and Jubo Sangram Parishad, formed by eight youth fronts of the main opposition parties, held a joint meeting on Monday at DUCSU Bhavan to discuss about the hartal today Tuesday and on November 26.
