



CUCSU to cooperate with varsity adminn

CHITTAGONG, Apr. 20: A meeting of Chittagong University Central Students Union (CUCSU), held today with the Vice-Chancellor and President of CUCSU Prof. Alamgir Muhammad Serajuddin in the chair, extended whole-hearted cooperation to university administration in maintaining peace and discipline on the campus on the eve of re-opening of the university, a university Press release said, reports BSS.

The university reopens on April 24 after remaining closed for four months following December 22 last incident in which one student died and several others were injured. A commission was also formed to probe the incident.

The CUCSU meeting was also attended by Vice-Presidents and General Secretaries of hall unions.

The meeting appealed to all concerned to cooperate with the university administration in maintaining law and order on the campus when it reopens.

The university authority at a recent meeting decided to allow police on the campus in order to ensure peace and order there.

The university halls reopen tomorrow.

A section of teachers and students have been demanding removal of the Vice-Chancellor on various grounds including nepotism and favouritism in discharge of his responsibilities.

BIT students held with arms

Rauzan police here today arrested four persons including three students of Bangladesh Institute of Technology (BIT), along with some arms and ammunition, police said.

Police also seized a microbus of the BIT in which they were travelling in.

On suspicion, police searched the microbus at Kadalpur under Rauzan Upazila while it was proceeding towards BIT at Pahartali and found one SMG, one magazine with 14 rounds of SMG ammunition, 100 rifle ammunition-one, vacant magazine and one iron rod.

Police also arrested the driver of the microbus.

A case was filed with Rauzan police in this connection.
