

Male students of JU leave campus

SAVAR, May 20: Jahangirnagar University campus was desolate today as most of the male students left the campus following yesterday's clash between two rival groups of Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal, reports BSS.

Female students, however, did not leave the campus.

Most of the male students left the campus fearing further attack from the near by village where members of one group are reportedly hiding.

A heavy contingent of police has been deployed and they are patrolling the campus.

Meanwhile, Savar police arrested two persons in connection with yesterday's violence. Dr. Khondokar Mosaraf Hossain, State Minister for Energy and Mineral Resources, after attending a seminar at the university today, ordered the police officials deployed in the campus to ensure peace and security of the students.

The injured students who were admitted to Dhaka Medical College Hospital yesterday are recovering quickly. Jamaluddin Runu of Geology Department and student Senate Member Rezaul Karim were released from the hospital today.

Halim, a Final Year student of Geography, is still critical, the DMC Hospital sources said.

The Election Commission for Jahangirnagar University Central Students Union (JUCSU) told BSS that they were preparing for the JUCSU and hall union's elections scheduled to be held on June 5.
