34 residents of DU halls given 4 days' remand

All the 34 persons arrested from different halls of the Dhaka University in Wednesday's raid by the law-enforcing agencies were brought to four days' police remand at Ramna thana Thursday, reports UNB.

Police sources said all those students and outsiders arrested from the six residential halls were charged under section 54 of the DMP Ordinance.

All of them were earlier produced before the court which sent them to police remand for further interrogation.

During the raid, police recovered huge quantity of arms and ammunition along with two wireless sets from the residential halls in the early hours Wednesday and arrested 34 persons including JCD International Affairs Secretary Golam Faroque Ovee.

Police, however, did not disclose the number of students and outsiders from among those arrested.

DU firm to root out terrorism

Meanwhile, Dhaka University Vice-Chancellor Prof. Abdul Mannan Thursday said that the authorities were determined to root out armed terrorism from the campus at any cost.

"Those vested quarters, which harbour hooliganism in the Dhaka University, do not care for the students' educated," he said while speaking at the freshers' reception of the Departments of Applied Chemistry and Business Administration at TSC.

Prof. Mannan also cautioned against the evil effects of scribblings at examinations and asked the students not to raise demands for shifting examination dates.
