

Show cause on DU V-C for cancelling exams

A Division Bench comprising Mr. Justice Abdul Matin Khan Chowdhury and Mr. Justice Naimuddin Ahmed of the High Court Division of the Supreme Court of Bangladesh has issued a Rule Nisi upon the Vice-Chancellor, the Pro-Vice-Chancellor, the Registrar of the University of Dhaka and others to show cause within three weeks why the impugned order passed by the Controller of Examinations cancelling the B.A., B.Com. (Pass) examination for the year 1988 of Dhanbari Degree College centre, Upazilla and District Tangail should not be declared to have been made without lawful authority and is of no legal effect and why they should not be directed to publish the result of B.A. and B. Com (Pass) examination for the year 1988 of the said Dhanbari Degree College centre.

Mir Shaiful Huq in his writ petition has challenged the validity of the impugned order of cancellation of B.A. and B.Com Examination of Dhanbari degree College centre held in 1988. The petitioner was the examinee of the said centre. He has taken the ground among others that by the impugned order the examination centre at Dhanbari Degree College was cancelled without showing any reason.
