

## DU classes resume Sept 17

Dhaka University Syndicate at an emergency meeting held on Saturday decided to reopen the university on September 17.

Presided over by Vice-Chancellor Prof. M. Maniruzzaman Miah, the meeting also decided to reopen all the residential halls for the students on September 16 and the classes will resume on September 17.

Vice-Chancellor Prof. M. Maniruzzaman Miah informed the members of the Syndicate that there was a growing demand from all quarters including students and guardians for immediate reopening of the university. Prof. Maniruzzaman Miah also informed them about the decisions of the meetings of Dhaka University Teachers Association and University

Education Environment Council.

Reviewing the present situations the meeting took the decision for reopening of the University. The meeting hoped that the members of the law enforcing agencies would take measures to help maintain peace and discipline on the campus.

The meeting expected that all concerned including political parties, students organisation and guardians would extend their all out support to help maintain congenial atmosphere on the campus.

The University was closed on July 30 following a three hour gun battle between the activists of Chhatra League (A-A) and Jatiyatahad Chhatra Dal. Five students received bullet injuries in the clashes.
