Decision on reopening of Varsity within two weeks: VC

Prof. M. Maniruzzaman Miah, Vice-Chancellor of Dhaka University on Monday assured the students that the decision on reopening of the University and its residential halls would be announced within a couple of weeks.

While addressing a group of students led by Dhaka University Education Action Committee (DUEAC) at his office he said that the University authorities were trying hard for early reopening of the University.

DUEAC leaders narrated the miseries of general students and examinees and opined that the violence could not be prevented by

closure of the University. They called for the University authorities to take effective steps for reopening of the University as early as possible.

Meanwhile, Bangladesh Chhatra Maitree, Chhatra Federation and Chhatra League (S-S) in separate statements on Monday expressed deep concern over closure of Dhaka University and demanded immediate reopening of the University.

The Officers' Association of Dhaka University (DUOA) in a Press conference on Monday blamed Vice-Chancellor, Prof. M. Maniruzzaman Miah, for non-implementation of its 13-point charter of demands.

Organised at TSC, the Press conference was addressed by Mohammad Selim and Abdul Haq, President and General Secretary of the Association.

They said that the Syndicate the highest decision making body of the university— had approved our demands. But Vice-Chancellor Prof. M. Maniruzzaman Miah did not take the necessary steps to implement the demands.
