DU classes resume July 6

The Dhaka University classes will resume July 6 (Saturday) instead of July 1, according to a decision taken by the Dhaka University Syndicate at a meeting Thursday, says BSS.

Presided over by the Vice-Chancellor, Prof. M. Maniruzzaman, the meeting decided to reopen the University offices on July 1 and the residential halls on July 5 (Friday) at 6 a.m. instead of June 29.

The Dhaka University Syndicate at its meeting discussed in detail the law and order situation on the campus.

The Vice-Chancellor informed the meeting that it was not clear to the authorities concerned what would be the possible situation after the reopening of the university on July 1 in the absence of students on the campus during the vacation.

Besides, most of the leaders of student organisations were now outside Dhaka or the country, he said.

The VC felt the necessity of holding discussions with the leaders of student organisations involved with the Academic Environment Council before the reopening of the University.

According to the decisions of the Syndicate, the Vice-Chancellor will continue his efforts for restoration of peace and harmony among the student organisations.

A meeting of Provosts, house tutors, assistant house tutors and the teacher-members of the Syndicate will be convened shortly to take necessary steps after discussions on hall administration and University law and order situation.
