DU halls vacated

All the resident students of Dhaka University vacated their respective halls by 8 a.m. on Wednesday following the directives of the University authorities.

The Dhaka University took the decision Tuesday evening following violent clashes between the activists of Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) and the Bangladesh Chhatra League (A-A). At least five students received bullet injuries during the gun-battle.

The sudden closure of the halls brought miseries to many resident students specially the female students who have no relatives in the city.

Police kept all the entry points to the Campus closed for traffic till Wednesday and continued patrolling the area.

The TSC area was humming with activities again in the afternoon when some of the students and cultural activists gathered there.
