

Student body demands reopening of DU

Some general students of Dhaka University on Tuesday formed an 11-member committee titled "Dhaka University Education Action Committee" with a view to materialising their demand for immediate reopening of the University and its 14 halls, reports BSS.

The Committee was formed at a general meeting held at the TSC lawn of the University with Selim Reza Newton in the chair.

The meeting reviewed the overall situation on the campus and the problems of the resident students due to closure of the University. The Committee demanded of the University Syndicate to reopen the University by August 16.

The Committee also announced programmes which include silent procession from the University campus to the National Press Club on August 8, a rally at the National Press Club on August 12, sit-in demonstration in front of the VC's office on August 14 and submission of a memorandum to the Syndicate the same day.
