DU VC urged to expel armed elements from halls

Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) on Tuesday submitted a memorandum to the Vice-Chancellor of Dhaka University demanding expulsion of terrorists from the residential halls of the University within a week.

In the memorandum the JCD leaders said armed elements were reading in some residential halls including Zahurul Haq, Salimullah, Jagannath and Mohsin Hall and the general students were besieged by them.

Earlier, JCD held a rally in front

of the DUCSU building which was addressed, among others, by JCD Secretary Ilias Ali, Sayed Uddin Ani, Moniruzzaman Manir, and Ali Akkas Nadim.

Speakers at the rally alleged that the terrorist group of BCL were hampering the normal academic activities of the campus through creating violence for a long time. They urged the University authorities to identify those elements and take necessary action against them according to the University law.

They also blamed the BCL for killing Shafiqul Islam in the city on Monday and demanded punishment to those responsible for the incident.
