

Shifting of DU exams demanded

Honours and Masters examinees of Dhaka University Tuesday stormed offices of some top officials demanding that their exams be deferred, reports UNB.

Both the examinations are scheduled to begin on June 30, and the authorities have already published detailed timetable.

The students again meet with the Pro-Vice Chancellor and Deans Tuesday to press home their demand.

Describing the present situation as uncongenial, they said the campus was volatile and residents were not attentive to their studies owing to continued gunfight.

The examinees many residents of Zahurul Haq, Jagannath and Salimullah halls and already left their dormitories for fear of fresh bloodshed.

"Our life has become insecure... It's impossible for me to appear at the examinations," a resident of Salimullah Hall said when the examinees went to meet with Pro-VC Dr. Wakil Ahmed.

The students said the Pro-VC gave a patient hearing to them and assured of considering the demand.

Meanwhile, the Pro-VC has convened a meeting of chairmen of all departments on June 4 to discuss the issues of shifting the date of examinations.
