

Steps to shift Islamic Varsity to original site taken

KUSHTIA, July 20:— The newly-appointed Vice-Chancellor of the Islamic University Professor Dr. Abdul Hamid said that efforts are being made to shift the university to its original site at Shantidanga, Dulatpur 15 miles from Kushtia town by July 1992. All construction work are expected to be completed by that time; he hoped.

The Vice-Chancellor was talking to the newsmen at his office yesterday evening. The Vice-Chancellor sought cooperation of all for smooth functioning of the university.

It may be pointed out were that classes of First Year Honours Students, shall begin at the present temporary site of the university in Kushtia town by the first week of September, according to information available from the University authority. There are at present departments including five new departments such as English, Bengali, Arabic, Islamic History and Culture, Politics and Public Administration. A total of 37 full time teachers are working at the moment.
