

# Grand confice of pry. school teachers

ULLAPARA, Sept. 20:—A conference of the primary school teachers of Ullapara Upazila with a view to improving the overall standard of Primary Education was held at Ullapara Auditorium Hall on Sept. 12 with the UNO Md. Surat Ali

in the chair and DC of Serajganj district Md Mosharraf Hossain as the chief guest. Several elite of the Upazila including the Ex-MP Md. Abdul Latif Mirza and other Govt. Officers of the Upazila attended the conference.

The conference began with a Telawat from the Holy Quran. At the beginning the DC in favour of the Upazila Primary Teachers offered Tk. 3000/- or each to three widows of the head teachers and Tk. 500/- each to seven retired Teachers. Association.
