Without Admission Test

Sir,

I am astonished to observe the news published on the 8th September in a vernacular daily that under an announcement of the Education Ministry all kinds of admission in colleges and Universities will be implemented according to the academic results not admission test results. According to this system, all kinds of admission test have been abolished, which were the main condition for earning higher education.

This system is not acceptable for the following causes:

This system will discriminate between rural and urban students because, naturally the urban students make better results than a rural students. Its main causes are that the rural students are deprived of some facilities like good tutors and suitable educational environment. Even urban colleges have the subject facilities and course and those are able to earn good marks, like shorthand, statistics, home economics, geography, etc.

This system will not be the best process to judge merit. It is acceptable data that last year five meritorious students who had participated

in the admission test failed to get a chance in Dhaka University. Again, some students who had not one first division and one second division have been able to get a chance in Dhaka University.

This system will be prone to unfair means in the S.S.C and H.S.C. exams because the students will be led into thinking that getting higher marks is the best way to earn higher education and they will endeavour to get good marks through unfair means.

So, I request the Education Ministry to consider the above and continue the previous system in the greatest interest of the students.
