35 nomination papers submitted

A total of 35 nomination papers have been submitted against 15 posts of Dhaka University Teachers' Association (DUTA) election which is scheduled to be held on December 30.

Of the 35 nomination papers 15 were submitted by Awami League-backed "Blue" Panel while other 20 nomination papers were submitted by BNP backed "White" Panel.

There are four panels in Dhaka University: Awami League-backed "Blue" panel, BNP backed "White" Panel, Jamaat-e-Islami-backed another "White" panel and Independent Pink group. Jamaat-e-Islami-backed "White" group and "Pink" group did not submit any nomination paper.
