

DU teachers rally against Gulf war

The teachers of the Dhaka University on Monday brought out a procession in protest against the Gulf war, reports BSS.

The procession, organized by the DU Teachers' Association (DUTA), began at the foot of the Aparajeya Bangla of the University Arts Building and dispersed at the Central Shaheed Minar after parading the T.S.C. and Doel Chattar (square).

The DUTA leaders, while speaking briefly at the Shaheed Minar, called upon the warring sides to stop hostilities and sit at a dialogue table.

The leaders who included Prof. Anwarullah Chowdhury and Prof. M. Shahadat Ali, President and General Secretary of the Teachers' Association, called for withdrawal of multinational forces from the Gulf area and retreat of Iraq from the soil of Kuwait.

They opined that peace would not be restored in the Middle-East till the end of Israeli occupation of Arab land and a just solution to Palestine problem.
