

RUTA strike continues

Resentment among RU teachers

RAJSHAHI, Jan. 21:—A resentment among the teachers of Rajshahi University has been created centering the appointment of some pro-Jamaat teachers in some vital posts by the Vice-Chancellor of the University, Prof M. Yousuf Ali during the last two days.

Campus sources said the vice-Chancellor appointed a pro-Jamaat teacher Prof Sarwar Zahan Department of Zoology as the Provost of Shamsuzzuha Hall removing Prof Abdur Rahman Siddique 16-month ahead of expiring of his provost tenureship. The sources further said, Prof Abdur Rahman Siddique is one of the main figure of the present anti-VC movement.

The Vice-Chancellor also appointed a pro-Jamaat teacher Prof Noor Muhammad, Department of Geography as the student adviser of the University. Prof S.Q.G Mahtabwali was appointed as the chairman of Military Science Department.
