

No classes in CU for 2nd day

CHITTAGONG, Nov. 24:—Complete strike was observed in Chittagong University today for the second day which began Saturday.

All Party Students Unity and CUCSU jointly called this strike for indefinite period on the campus to protest the alleged attack on Vice-Chancellor's residence by Islami Chhatra Shibir activists recently and demanding the arrest of the alleged killer of student leader Farukazman Faruk, restoration of academic atmosphere on the campus and removal of sixty three Islami Chhatra Shibir activists from the university.

Classes and all official works in the university remained suspended for the second day of the indefinite strike today.

However, the examination of the Honours final year was held as per new schedule announced by the University authority on Wednesday last.

Earlier, APSU in a Press statement announced that the examinations of all level would remain outside the strike programme.

At a rally APSU leaders called upon the concerned authority to free the campus from the grip of what they called terrorist of Islami Chhatra Shibir. They said that the campus was virtually a hostage at the hand of Shibir activists for a quite long time.

Shibir submits memorandum

Meanwhile, Islami Chhatra Shibir, Chittagong University Unit, who have been agitating for a long time demanding removal of VC and implementation of CU enquiry commission report today urged the Government to take necessary measures to appoint a neutral Vice-Chancellor in Chittagong University by removing the incumbent to normalise the prevailing situation. They also demanded arrest of killers of Shibir workers and withdrawal of fake cases registered against the Islami Chhatra Shibir leaders.

Meanwhile, Islami Chhatra Shibir, Chittagong University Unit yesterday submitted a memorandum to the Deputy Commissioner, Mr. A.R. Khan. They said the terrorists under the banner of the former CUCSU and backed by the Vice-Chancellor, who was accused by a judicial inquiry commission, have thrown negative programmes aiming at marking the life of 12 thousand students miserable.
