

Removal of CU V-C demanded

CHITTAGONG, July 5:—A joint meeting of teachers, guardians and professionals, held at the Muslim Institute Hall here today, demanded removal of the Vice-Chancellor of the Chittagong University immediately to end the long-drawn crisis of the university, reports BSS.

Presided over by Mr. A.K.M. Rafiqullah Chowdhury, a BNP leader and former MP, the meeting warned that if the Vice-Chancellor was not removed by tomorrow (Saturday), an action programme would be announced in this connection.

The meeting urged the Government to stop meeting of the university Senate, scheduled to be held on July 7, saying it was in contravention

The meeting also called upon the Government to publish and implement the inquiry commission report on December 22 incident of the university.
