## CU VC begins dialogue with feuding groups

CHITTAGONG, Mar. 5.—The Vice-Chancellor of Chittagong University again started dialogue with all feuding groups on the campus in a bid to resolve the crisis that crippled the campus life for the past one and a half years.

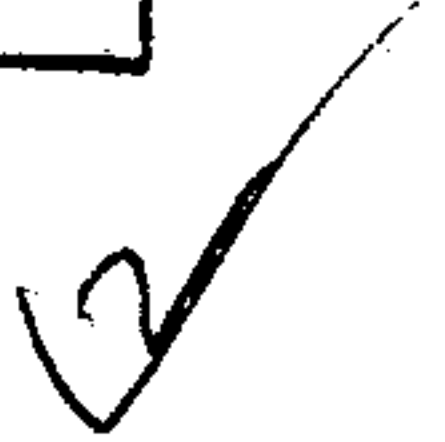
The Vice-chancellor Prof. Rafique Islam Chowdhury already held meeting with the leaders of General Teachers Parishad which took side of former Vice-Chancellor. The Parishad leaders present at that meeting were Prof. Ali Emdad Khan, Prof. Hamida Banu, Prof. Anupom Sen and Prof. Abdul Mannan.

The Vice-Chancellor also met the Jatiyatabadi Shikkhak Parishad members and some student leaders to discuss the situation on the campus.

The dialogue of the University authority with all these feuding groups seemingly could not yet yield much positive result. But the University authority is optimistic of an amicable solution to the prevailing problem.

Meanwhile, the Islami Chhatra Shibir has drawn up an eleven-day programme to press home the resumption of classes in Chittagong University. The eleven-day long programmes include exchange of views with professional bodies and associations, presentation of memorandum to the district administration and holding of rallies.
