CHITTAGONG, Feb 5:—The University of Chittagong will hold its first convocation on Sunday to confer degrees on 2678 successful students.

This will be the first convocation of Chittagong University since the Liberation of the country. The Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia will preside over the convocation.

The 2678 degree holders who registered their names for convocation successfully passed their examinations from this university during the 14 years from 1968 to 1982. Of these total degree holders, 1098 persons will be conferred with B.A., B.Sc. and B.Com., 438 with the degrees of honours in B.A., B.Sc., and B.Com., 907 with Master degree in Arts, Science and Commerce, 47 with B.Ed. degree, 35 with L.L.B. degree, 143 with Bachelor degree of Science in Engineering, 6 with M.B.B.S. degree and 27 with Ph.D. Besides, 17 past meritorious students will be conferred with chancellor's gold medal, according to a University Press release.
