### Classes suspended

## CU student succumbs to injuries

CHITTAGONG, Aug 22:—All classes of Chittagong University have been suspended for three days till Monday following death of a student who was earlier injured in an attack by a student group, reports UNB.

Sanjay Talapatra, a second year student of Fine Arts Department of CU, succumbed to his injuries at the Chittagong Medical College Hospital this (Saturday) morning.

An activist of Chhatra Union, Sanjay, along with nine other students were seriously injured on Thursday in the attack allegedly by the Islami Chhatra Shibir activists during distribution of leaflets in university shuttle train at Chittagong station.

A case was filed against 18 Shibir activists, including two top leaders, with Kotwali police.

Following the death of Sanjay today, additional police have been deployed on the CU campus and student dormitories to avert any untoward incident.

The university authorities have formed a three-member inquiry committee to investigate into the incident.

Sanjay, only son of Kanailal Talapatra of Comilla, was cremated at the Avaymitra Crematorium this afternoon. Pro-VC Dr. Abu Yusuf Alam garlanded the body of Sanjay.

Meanwhile, Chhatra Union and Chhatra League brought out separate processions on the campus in protest against the killing and Chhatra Union submitted memoranda to the Pro-VC and Police Commissioner.

The Pro-VC in a statement today urged the police authorities to immediately arrest the identified terrorists who made the attack on Sanjay and general students at Chittagong railway station.
