CU classes resume

CHITTAGONG, May 31:— The University of Chittagong today resumed classes of students after a lapse of fifteen days.

The university suspended the classes of students and all examinations following killing of Mohammed Zubair Hossain, an MA class student of Economics and activist of Shibir by the rivals on the campus on May 15. Later a pro-AL Chhatra League activist and MA final year student of Economics Saiful Islam was also killed in an accidental gun fire.

A 3-member committee set up by the Syndicate has been inquiring into the causes of these bloody incidents and to hold persons responsible for the incidents. Professor Dr. Huzzat Ali Pramanik of Physics heads the committee.

However, there was a humming of students and day passed peacefully on the opening day today. The university buses and shuttle trains carrying teachers and students plied as usual. More than 300 police personnel deployed for maintenance of law and order.

Meanwhile, the Jamaat's student front—Islami Chhatra Shibir which laid siege to Chittagong University from May 20 put off its all agitation programmes following a fruitful meeting with the Vice Chancellor Professor Abdul Mannan at his campus residence on Sunday night. The pro-Vice Chancellor Prof Abu Yusuf Alam was also present at the meeting.

The Vice Chancellor assured the Shibir leaders to consider their 5-point demands put up in the meeting.
