Classes of CU resume today

CHITTAGONG, Jan 15:—The classes of Chittagong University will resume tomorrow (Sunday) amidst tense situation after a month long vacation.

The situation is expected to become tense as Islami Chhatra Shibir, (ICS) student wing of Jaamat-e-Islami, called for a strong demonstration programme from today (Sunday) while the CU unit of pro-Awami League student organisation Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) have declared to resist the demonstration of ICS.

Meanwhile, the university authorities have put a ban on all kinds of processions and rallies on the campus from tomorrow (Sunday) for an indefinite period of time. Police have been deployed on the campus to ensure security.

ICS threatened the authorities that they would call for an indefinite strike on the campus if the killers of two of their members were not arrested immediately. Earlier, on December 19, two ICS activists were killed in a clash between ICS and BCL. The victims were identified as Rahimuddin, a second year student of the department of Bengali, and Mahmudul Hasan, a fourth year student of the Department of Finance.
