

DU classes resume tomorrow

Classes in the Dhaka University will resume tomorrow (Sunday). All necessary steps have been taken by the University authority to hold classes smoothly. Residential halls of the university reopened on Tuesday last amid tight security.

Dhaka University had been closed since July 15 following an armed clash between the supporters of Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal and Chhatra League pro-JSD (Inu) in which three persons including two students were killed.

A meeting of the Dhaka University Educational Environment Council was held on Friday at the administrative building under the chairmanship of Prof. Abdul Mannan, Vice-Chancellor of the University. The meeting in a resolution decided that it would hold a meeting of the teachers, students and employees of the University.
