

VC's letter to guardians

Motivate students to abide by DU rules

Prof. Abdul Mannan, Vice-Chancellor of the Dhaka University has written letters to the guardians of the students of the University seeking their cooperation in maintaining peace and harmony on the campus.

Narrating the series of untoward incidents taking place on the campus the Vice-Chancellor commented that the students have been harmed following continuous hooliganism and terrorism.

Prof. Mannan hoped that the guardians would extend their full support to the steps taken by the university to restore normalcy and weed out armed hooligans from the campus.

The Vice-Chancellor said their

motives were not to punish any one but to bring sanity on the campus.

The Vice-Chancellor said that the Syndicate of the University has decided to reopen the university on September 27 and to implement the rules and regulations of the university strictly.

Prof Abdul Mannan expressed his hope that the law enforcing agencies would help the varsity authorities to detect the sources of arms on the campus.

He urged the guardians to motivate their sons, daughters, brothers and sisters to abide by the rules of the university and halls. He reiterated firm determination of the university administrations for bringing back congenial academic life on the campus.
