

JNU incident BCL blames ICS for attack

Different student bodies staged demonstrations in the city in protest against on Monday's clash at Jagannath University among the three student organisations which left 50 injured.

Awami League backed Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) staged demonstration on the Dhaka University campus on Tuesday blaming Islami Chhatra Shibir (ICS) for the Monday's clash.

ICS staged a rally in front of Baitul Mukarram mosque protesting the BCL attack on them and claimed that at least 40 ICS leaders and activists were injured.

Bangladesh Chhatra Union staged a rally at Bahadur Shah Park in the city protesting the

Monday's clash and blamed ICS for the attack on BCL activists.

Addressing a rally the BCL President Mazharul Islam Ripon urged leaders and activists to resist Shibir wherever they would be found. "Shibir will not be allowed in the Dhaka University and Jagannath University", Ripon said, adding that "the BCL activists are ready to sacrifice blood to resists Shibir".

Later BCL brought out a procession where the angry BCL men vowed to resist the Shibir activists and drive them out from the campus.

The ICS leaders said that, they have the right to protect themselves and they will manage their self protection in future, if the BCL attack them further.

ICS President Selimuddin Selim and General Secretary Zahidur Rahman addressed the rally among others.

All classes and examination were suspended on Tuesday as the authorities closed the university for three days on Monday. University sources said that the vacation period may be extended. No student organisations were allowed to hold any programmes on the campus. A huge contingent of police was deployed to avoid further untoward incident.
