

DUTA to bring silent rally today protesting attack on Dr Aftab

Dhaka University Teachers' Association (DUTA) will bring out a silent procession on the campus today (Tuesday) protesting Saturday's terrorist attack on Prof Dr Aftab Ahmed, reports UNB.

The decision was taken in an emergency meeting of the DUTA executive committee with DUTA President Sharif Ullah Bhuiyan in the chair.

The meeting strongly condemned the savage attack on Prof Aftab, former VC of National University and a teacher of Dhaka University's Political Science Department, and demanded immediate arrest and punishment of the attackers.

The procession will be brought out at 11:00 am from 'Aparajeya Bangla' and terminated at Central Shaheed Minar after parading the campus.

The DUTA meeting also demanded proper medical treatment of Dr Aftab and urged the government to bear all the expenses of his treatment.

They also urged the university authorities to ensure security of the teachers on the campus and introduce caller ID system in land phones of the teachers.
