DUCSU polls shifted to August 5

The elections to the Dhaka University Central Students' Union (DUCSU) will now be held on August 5 instead of July 31 as announced earlier.

The date of DUCSU elections was changed at a joint meeting of the Dhaka University Syndicate, provosts, proctor, Dhaka University Teachers Association, Officers Association and other university employees' bodies held on Sunday.

Presided over by Vice Chancellor Prof. Mniruzzaman Miah, the joint meeting reviewed the prevailing situation on the campus and refixed the date for DUCSU polls to facilitate the student organisations who failed to file their nominations owing

to various problems.

According to changed schedule, the last date for submission of nomination papers has been fixed on July 25.

The meeting expected that the student organisations would participate in the DUCSU polls to uphold the glorious image of DUCSU.

According to new schedule, the authorities will distribute the nomination papers from July 21 to 24 and will receive the papers on July 25 and the paper will be scrutinised on the same day.

The provisional list of candidates will be announced on July 25 and the date of withdrawal of nomination papers has been fixed on July 30.

The final list of candidates will be announced on July 31.
