An Appeal To PM

Sir,

Khulna University, is the only government university in Bangladesh that is still free from student politics. With due honour and respect, we the students of this university would like to inform both our Honourable President and the Chancellor of this varsity of our own feelings and thoughts.

We have been boycotting all our classes since June 28, of this year to keep our campus free from politics and terrorism. We had no other choice but to do so to protest against political and unruly activities on our very own campus. This anarchic situation started at the beginning of this year when the construction work of our ladies hostel was finished. At first the hostel was supposed to be named Khulna University ladies hostel. But soon after its construction, the authority, decided to name it after some political persons.

Having a politics-free campus we protested against this decision at once as we don't want any political affair to intrude into our varsity. We then proposed our ladies hostel to be named after "Taramon Bibi" in order to pay tribute to our great Independence War. Subsequently, we made a signboard and put it over that hostel.
