Undergraduate classes of BUET resume Nov 26

The undergraduate classes of all faculties of Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology (BUET) will resume on November 26. The residential halls will reopen on November 25.

The BUET was close sine die on October 26 for what the authority said the deteriorating situation on the campus as the students were continuing the boycott of classes from October 15 to press home their two points demand of enhancement of stipends and abolition of class test system.

In a notification issued by the Registrar of BUET on Sunday the authority called upon the students guardians and all concerned to cooperate for reestablishing congenial educational atmosphere on the campus. It said that the present academic session has already been delayed by two and a half months due the devastating flood, strike and unschedule closure of varsity. The statement added that the authority would take necessary steps for modification of the existing rules and regulations of the class test system if any problem arises.

The authority has already placed the issue of enhancement of stipends to the Government and would continue its efforts in this regard, the statement said. The authority hoped that the students would realise the situation and show responsibility.

Guardians' Assoc

Meanwhile, National Guardians Association in a Press release on Sunday underscored the need of proper rules and regulations of class test system. It supported the other demand of the students to increase the amount of stipends. The President and General Secretary of the association Mr. Dr. A.M. A. Zaman and Mr. A.K.M. Emdadul Hoque respectively met the Acting Vice-Chancellor of BUET Prof. Iqbal Mahmood recently and urged them to settle the issues through negotiation.
