DUTA election Monday

Election to the Dhaka University Teachers Association (DUTA) will be held on Monday, reports UNB.

Prof. Sultan Ahmed of Soil Science, who was appointed Election Commissioner, announced the schedule on December 11.

About 850 teacher of the university are eligible to cast their ballots from 10 am to 2 pm to elect of 15-member executive committee of the association for a one-year term.

A total of 30 candidates from two panels are contesting the polls. Nomination papers were submitted on December 15 and scrutinised the following day.

The two panels are white and the joint panel of pink-and-blue. The panels are named after the colour of their respective leaflets.

The white panel nominated Dr. Anwarullah Chowdhury, Dean of Social Science Faculty and Syndicate member for the post of President, and Syndicate member Dr. Anwar Hosain of Bio-chemistry Department for General Secretary.

Dr. Abdul Jabbar Miah of Chemistry Department and Prof Shahadat Ali of Zoiology were nominated as candidates for President and General Secretary respectively from the joint pink-blue panel.
