Non-govt school, college teachers' rally tomorrow

A rally of the teachers and employees of non-government high schools and colleges will be held tomorrow (Sunday) at the Central Shaheed Minar at 10 a.m.

Leaders of the Central Teachers' Action Liaison Committee called upon all teachers and employees of non-government schools and colleges to attend the rally to intensify the ongoing movement for realisation of four-point demand.

A meeting of Liaison Committee will be held today (Saturday) at its office to review the latest situation of the on-going strike by teachers and employees.

Meanwhile, the President of Bangladesh College Teachers' Association Principal A.K.M. Zahirul Islam and General Secretary Kazi Farook Ahmed protested the statement in an interview given to UNB by Education Minister Barrister Jamiruddin Sircar and termed the comment of the Minister concocted.

They demanded of the Prime Minister to immediately remove the present Education Minister and hold him responsible for the deadlock in the Education sector.

Bangladesh Shikkhak Samity President Ashraf Ali and Secretary General Nazrul Islam in a joint statement on Friday protested against the interview given by the Education Minister. They demanded nationalisation of services of teachers and employees of non-government secondary schools in the greater interest of the nation.
