

JCD calls strike tomorrow

Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) will observe strike in all the educational institutions of the country on August 24 in protest against the police attack on JCD President Shahiduddin Chowdhury Anny and capturing the university halls by the ruling party's student front Bangladesh Chhatra League.

Addressing a protest rally at the Aparajeyo Bangla of Dhaka University the JCD leaders announced the programme. They will also hold a countrywide protest rally tomorrow protesting the activities of BCL members.

The JCD members said that the Chhatra League workers in cooperation with armed outsiders and police attacked their members when they brought out a procession on the campus in support of their strike programme. Chhatra League workers opened fire and chased the JCD activists without any provocation, they alleged.

The Chhatra Dal members said terrorists of the Chhatra League captured the Mohsin Hall of the university with the assistance of police. They condemned BCL (S-P) for the attack at the Mohsin Hall.
